## Pomelos

Pomelos are available from December through early March. These are the largest citrus fruit and are often referred to as a “Chinese grapefruit”. They have a round to pear shape. Pomelos have a smooth skin which ranges from white to light green in color. This fruit is known for its very thick rind and pink interior flesh. They have a sweet taste which has a similar flavor to grapefruit with a less acidic taste. Specialty packs available on request.

Cara Caras are a special variety of navel orange. The exterior skin has a bright orange skin like regular navels but the interior skin is a dark pink color. They are also a seedless variety, very juicy and are low acid. Cara Cara’s are available from January through April.

## Minneolas

These are available January through March. Minneolas are a medium to large size orange with a unique shape. This fruit is easily identifiable because of the large knob at the end of the fruit. It has a deep red-orange exterior color. Minneolas have a sweet-tart taste along with a high juice content with few seeds.

## Oro Blancos

Oro Blancos are a cross between an acid-less pomelo and a white grapefruit. They have a thick, bright green to yellow rind and are generally round in shape. Oro Blancos are sweeter tasting than a grapefruit. They can be peeled and eaten like an orange. However, the white membrane surrounding the flesh should be discarded as it has a bitter taste. Oro Blancos are available October through March.

# Citrus Specialties

## Moro Oranges (Blood oranges)

These are available January through mid-April. Moro oranges have a deep orange exterior color with a dark red or maroon interior. Moros have a combination of a strong orange flavor with a hint of raspberry. They contain anthocyanin which is what produces the dark red interior color and is also a powerful anti-aging antioxidant. Moros are generally easy to peel and have few if any seeds.

## Mandarins

These are available November through April. The three main varieties of mandarins are Satsumas (seedless), Honey Mandarins (seeded) and Royal Mandarins (seeded). These are smooth skinned, juicy and relatively sweet tasting. They are often referred to as an “easy peeler”. Each variety has their own distinctive flavor. Satsumas are the first available mandarin and have a mild orange taste. Honey Mandarins are very aromatic and have a sweet taste like honey. Royal Mandarins have more of a sweet spicy flavor.
